Why Do this Course?

Yet research into how people think can provide us with interesting insights into why others behave differently and how this can actually strengthen rather than weaken a team. It enables us to not just understand others but employ strategies to harness the value that comes with diversity.

This workshop looks at how differences in our natural brain preferences affect how we interact with the world and each other.

About the Course

The workshop is highly interactive, providing participants with the chance to examine their own brain preferences with the help of the Myers Briggs Type Indicator® instrument and then explore how this knowledge can help them when working with others.

Participants will be able to reflect on their own brain preferences and consider what this means when working with others. They will also explore a range of strategies for making the most of the differing gifts that everyone in their team brings.

Course objectives

On completing this workshop you will be able to:

- identify how your innate personal brain preferences may differ from those with whom you work and manage
- identify how your own brain preferences influence how you interact with others
- recognise the different ways that people prefer to receive information about their matters that affect their everyday work
- recognise the different ways that people prefer to relate to their environment and how this affects their behaviour in different work situations
- use simple techniques to identify the communication and learning needs of others, with particular reference to the work environment
- adapt your leadership style to facilitate teamwork
- prepare a plan for making the most of the differences within your team.
